



What To Bring To Day Camp

Each child should bring a backpack to camp. Inside the backpack should be the following:

- Lunch
- Baseball Cap
- Bathing Suit (can be worn under clothing)
- Plastic bag for wet clothing
- Water Shoes
- Towel
- Bug Repellent
- Sunscreen
- Rain Poncho/Jacket
- Water Bottle
- Change of Clothing
- Spending Money for Trading Post

Note: Please label all items and clothing with camper's name.

Day Campers should wear the following to camp:

- Bug Repellent
- Sunscreen
- Camp Shirt (provided)
- Closed Toe Sandals (no flip flops)
- Sneakers or Hiking Boots
- Shorts or Jeans

What Not To Bring:

To name a few, toys, headphones, sharp objects, electronics such as, radios, video games, and cellphones, are not permitted for use at camp. Pouch Day Camp of Greater New York Councils, Boy Scouts of America will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Camp Security Procedures:

We encourage you to come and visit with us. Your child's safety is of paramount importance. When visiting Pouch Day Camp please make sure the following rules are observed.

1. All visitors must **sign-in and out** and obtain a **visitors pass** at the camp office before entering camp. There will be no exceptions!!
2. All visitors must remain with their **host at all times**.
3. All visitors are required to **follow the instructions of the Camp Staff** especially in regards to drills and emergency procedures.
